# What is The Wave Ranger Project?

---

The Wave Rangers is an entirely free project designed for youths to spend time in nature, learn new skills, make friends and reap the benefits of taking part in regular volunteering activities. The Wave Rangers is available for schools, groups of friends, community groups and individuals.

## What do I do on the Project?

Once signed up, the Wave Ranger co-ordinator will organise a time and a meeting place suitable for everyone to meet. Armed with pizzas and pens, the students will learn about the available volunteering activities such as beach cleans, dry-stone walling, footpath restoration, mammal surveys and tree planting. Whilst enjoying the pizzas, they will plan the activities they would like to do. If the students have their own volunteering ideas, we try and cater to their ideas so they can take ownership of their project. The students will learn about the John Muir Award which they will be working towards and have a log book to record their volunteering hours.

The volunteering activities are catered to your needs. It can be once a week, once a fortnight or in a few consecutive days. It can be during the school day (for school groups) or outside of school hours, during term time and school holidays.

The regular volunteering activities then commence. The parents, guardians or teachers are kept informed with the plan for each session. The students will finish the project with a minimum of 25 hours of volunteering. This will have earned them the Discovery Level of the John Muir Award.

At the end of their 25 hours, there will be a celebration picnic at the beach, an optional free surfing lesson and presentation of certificates. The students are encouraged to continue volunteering with the Wave Rangers project.
